The City of Selma, Alabama, is pleased to submit the following project proposal for consideration in the FY 2023 Rebuild Alabama Act County Transportation Plan for financial assistance toward the City of Selma's Downtown Street Resurfacing Project (DSRP).

The DSRP is of great local interest to the residents of Selma-Dallas County to make improvements to select classified roads open to public traffic. The project is also of particular interest to the Commission as on average over 4.4 million vehicles travel through the Downtown corridor annually. The identified roadways provide direct access to Dallas County Courts, Sheriff, Administrative Offices, and several local businesses within the proposed project area.

The City of Selma has made significant investments to the underground infrastructure in the city blocks adjacent to the Dallas County Courthouse and Annex allocating approximately \$758,105.00 on storm water drainage and sanitary sewer projects. In addition to the \$821,700.00 proposed cost share amount requested from the Commission, the city is committed to seeking another \$750,000 toward the DSRP.

Since its incorporation in 1820, Selma has served as the epicenter of Dallas County having witnessed more than 200 years of history, but future opportunities for growth and economic prosperity remain bright.

Thank you for your continued service to the residents of Dallas County. We appreciate the opportunity to collaborate on this mutually beneficial and much needed project.

- Superpave Bituminous Concrete Wearing Surface Layer,
- Superpave Bituminous Concrete Upper Binder Layer, Leveling,
- Superpave Bituminous Concrete Upper Binder Layer, Patching,
- Striping
- Solid White, Class 2, Type A Traffic Stripe (5" Wide)
- Solid Yellow, Class 2, Type A, Traffic Stripe (5" Wide)
- Broken White, Class 2, Type A Traffic Stripe (5" Wide)
- Traffic Control Markings
- Loop Wire
- Construction Signs & Cones
