



We want to send a special thanks to the 3500+ Citizens who communicated with Liberty Disposal Incorporated (LDI) and the Tax and License Department during the implementation of the Re-engineered Garbage Ordinance where there was a transition of billing from occupants to property owners.

Property owners are responsible for paying Liberty Disposal Incorporated (LDI) quarterly for the garbage service at their respective properties.

Enforcement: The City of Selma will use the following methods to address garbage delinquency / debts: (1) Place a Lien on the property, (2) Report the debt to both the collection agency and credit reporting agency.
