

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



can put a 'motion' on the 'floor' after discussion." Councilwoman Thomas (Jannie) stated, "It's easy to say put a 'motion' on the 'floor' and 'vote'. We've got to look at the welfare of this City. We have to make sure the value of that asset is that amount of money. If the Lease is about to run out, can't we re-lease it to get some more?" Councilman Johnson stated, "I think this is something we really need to look at because this is something very valuable to the City. We will definitely lose money if we don't get this pit because right now, the way I understand it; we've got twenty- or thirty-years' worth of dirt that would probably be valued at close to a million dollars. If we don't get this, basically we have to pay off the lease at \$134,000.00; so, we might as well go ahead and buy it. We should go ahead and purchase it and it will be 'ours'." Councilman Harvill stated, "I think I asked this before but has there been a 'Geotech' done on this property? Is there dirt there? I'll tell you how they came up with that. They signed the contract; they gave the contract to the appraiser, and the appraiser 'appraised' it at the contract price. We're paying too much for the property; we do have a lease and a payoff. I'm going to tell you, I do think we are paying too much but I'm going to be in favor of exercising the contract." Councilman Carmichael stated, "I'm of the same opinion but I just want to say I appreciate the Executive Branch finally getting us the boring sample, the Geotech sample, so we actually know how much dirt is there, because it's been 'mined' for decades. I agree, I have not seen a price for land per acre done this high in Dallas County. I do believe it's good for the City to have its own dirt pit. It's more expensive than you probably realize and I'm afraid you may see some of that down the road but 'all in all', it's going to be better for us to have it." Councilman Harvill made a motion to purchase the dirt pit for the suggested price, \$134,000.00. The motion was seconded by Councilman Johnson. A roll call vote was taken and the motion passed with a unanimous vote of the Council Members present.

Resolution #R223-21/22, Building Repairs and Maintenance, Public Buildings. (Item Number 11.)

President Young stated, "This item is for building repairs and maintenance. This Invoice is from Carol's Carpet; also, from Bagby and from Steward Construction. This was Resolution R223-21/22, and they wanted to use American Rescue Plan Funds. They want to use it for carpeting, painting and an invoice from Bagby; all in one Resolution, Resolution #R223-21/22." Councilwoman Thomas (Jannie) stated, "Will this carpet be on all City Property that needs it, like the Convention Center?" President Young stated, "It will be for Selma City Hall, the Convention Center, Council Chambers and Offices, and the Evans Reception Center." Councilman Carmichael stated, "I'm concerned about exceeding Public Works Bid Law and I think we need to 'Table' this until we get an opinion on that. I just want to make sure we know that we can't do a contract for materials, and another for services, to get around the Bid Law. It's all one job." Councilwoman Thomas (Jannie) stated, "Didn't we do that the same way with the Recreation Department? They bought the materials, and they did the labor?" Councilman Carmichael stated, "The City Schools bought the materials and the City paid for the labor." President Young stated, "We want to be in compliance with the Bid Law regarding repairs and also for the carpet." Councilman Carmichael stated, "I want us to understand that we cannot split up a contract without it being a violation of the Alabama Bid Law. I need an understanding of this." Councilman Johnson asked, "Can we also receive an estimate from Carpet Plus for the installation of carpet for the Buildings?" It was the "Consensus" of the Council to get "answers" to "questions, including clarification regarding the inclusion of documents from Bagby Elevator Company.

This Item was "Tabled" until further information is received.

Purchase of Utility Line Locator. (Item Number 12.)

Councilman Harvill asked, "Why is the City of Selma asking for a Utility Line Locator, when we are required by State Regulation, to call '811', before digging?"

It was the "Consensus" of the Council to get said "answer" to above "question".

Resolution #R232-21/22, Emergency Purchase of A/C Unit - Evans Building. (Additional Item)

Mrs. Ivy S. Harrison, City Clerk, addressed the Council, and stated that she had some additional items from the Mayor's Office to present; an Emergency Purchase of an A/C Unit at the Evans Building in the amount of \$14,500.00 from Affordable Heating Air and Appliance Repair, in the form of Resolution #R232-21/22. Attorney Madison submitted said Resolution in support of this purchase. President Young stated, "Since we

haven't looked at the Resolution, I think we can just vote on the Purchase Order and come back and do the Resolution at another time. My recommendation is that we first transfer \$15,000.00 from the American Rescue Plan Funds to account #1.6022.51036.2 to pay for the air conditioner, and that we approve the purchase of an air conditioner for the Evans building." During discussion, Councilman Harvill made a motion to transfer \$15,000.00 from the American Rescue Plan Funds to Account #1.6022.51036.2, and to approve the purchase of an air conditioner from Affordable Heating Air and Appliance Repair. The motion was seconded by Councilwoman Thomas (Christie). A roll call vote was taken, and the motion passed with a unanimous vote of the Council Members present. Further, Councilman Carmichael stated, "For the record, the correct amount on the American Rescue Plan Account is \$421,816.01." President Young called for a unanimous consent from the Council to approve the expenditure. A roll call vote was taken, and unanimous consent of all Council Members present was given.

Councilwoman Thomas (Jannie) asked, "What is the balance of American Rescue Funds' Disbursement Account? Have we received the 'second' Disbursement?"

Resolution R225-21/22, Resolution to Veto Resolution XYZ, Council Action of June 14, 2022.

Mrs. Ivy S. Harrison, City Clerk, also addressed the Council, and presented the Council with Resolution R225-21/22, A Resolution to Veto Resolution XYZ Council Action of June 14, 2022. Mrs. Harrison stated, "For the record, I'm going to read Resolution #R225-21/22, Resolution to Veto Resolution XYZ, Council Action of June 14, 2022, in its entirety." Councilman Carmichael stated, "I'm not sure what 'XYZ' refers to." Mrs. Harrison stated that she thinks that it refers to the Historic Traffic Lights Resolution that was presented during the last Council Meeting, and that she did not have a copy of said Resolution, to give more information. Councilman Carmichael stated, "That was for a contract; it's not a permanent Resolution so he has no power to veto that. The only thing the Mayor has veto power over is permanent Resolutions. A contract is not permanent." Attorney Madison stated, "That's correct to an extent, but what he is vetoing is an action by a Council Member that is an Executive Action." Councilman Carmichael stated, "What I did was, ask for a quote for services from a company that specializes in this; there's only about 3 of them that do this. I asked for a 'quote'; I did not negotiate any contracts. A citizen of Selma can come to the Council with a 'quote'. When we were discussing this last spring, I got all the information from the League of Municipalities along with the AG's Opinion and I sent it to Everybody, that the Council has just about any authority over contracting that there is." Attorney Madison stated, "The issue was contracting in the previous contract, it was not a question of whether or not the Council or a Council Member was acting in an Executive capacity. The issue previously was a contract, and a contract is not your correct permanent action. So, the Mayor has no veto power over a contract. You are talking about a Resolution that can very easily be of a permanent nature if you put the lights up in a city and they stay up an indeterminate amount of time. So, it's a question of not just the contracting; it's a question of what action is being taken to get traffic lights in the City of Selma without any Executive input." President Young stated, "Council, we have a Resolution before us and a Veto. The Council has the option to accept the Veto or reject it with a 2/3 majority vote of the Council that is sitting. Is there a motion regarding Resolution #R225-21/22?" Councilman Johnson stated, "So moved." Council President Young stated, "This will be a motion to overrule the Resolution." Councilman Johnson withdrew his motion. Attorney Madison stated, "I wanted to read Section 11-45-4 Code of Alabama. Veto of Ordinances and Resolutions and passage over Veto. If the Mayor should disapprove of any Ordinance or Resolution transmitted to him as provided by Section 1-45-4 and 11-45-3, he shall in Ten (10) days of the time of its passage by the Council, return the same to the Clerk with his objections in writing and the Clerk shall make report thereof to the next regular meeting of the City Council, and if 2/3 of the members elected to the City Council shall adhere to said Ordinance or Resolution not withstanding said objections, said vote being taken by yeas or nays being spread upon the minutes, then and not otherwise, said Ordinance or Resolution shall have publication thereof by force of Law unless by its terms it was to take effect upon its approval in which it then shall take effect upon this passage over said Veto. The failure of the Mayor to return the Ordinance or Resolution to the Clerk his Veto within Ten (10) days after its passage by the Council shall operate and have the same effect as approval and publication of the same as provided by subsection B of Section 11-45-3 of publication of the Laws and Ordinances of said City." Councilman Harvill made a motion to overrule the Mayor's Veto. The motion was seconded by Councilwoman Thomas (Christie). A roll call vote was taken. There were Five (5) affirmative votes and Two (2) no votes. President Young, Councilman Harvill, Councilwoman Thomas (Christie), Councilman Carmichael, and Councilwoman Thomas (Jannie) all voted 'yes'. Councilman Johnson and Councilman Jemison voted "no". Following said roll call, Council President Young stated, "With Five (5) votes of the members present voting yes, the motion does not pass as it requires a 2/3 majority of the elected members, not the members present. However, from my understanding, that contract was done in a Resolution form, and so a contract not in Resolution form could possibly be brought back up." Councilman Carmichael stated, "Resolutions for contracts are not considered permanent Resolutions, and that's why he has no Veto Power over this." President Young stated, "But, to get some clarity on it, we may need to come back on it, as a contract."

RESOLUTION R270-21/22

RESOLUTION APPROVING A SPECIAL USE PERMIT FOR THE EXISTING MONOPOLE TOWER LOCATED AT 212 WASHINGTON STREET

WHEREAS, T-Mobile has requested to modify their equipment on the existing monopole tower located at 212 Washington Street, Selma, Alabama, to provide wireless services essentially within the corporate limits and police jurisdiction of the City of Selma, and;

WHEREAS, T-Mobile has complied with the City's Ordinance No. COS 013-00/01 and has demonstrated the need for a wireless facility to consistently deliver reliable services in the identified area, and;

WHEREAS, the City's consultant, The Center for Municipal Solutions (CMS), recommends the granting of a Special Use Permit for this facility located at 212 Washington Street, Selma, Alabama, which consists of an existing 106' self-support tower,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Selma, Alabama that T-Mobile is hereby granted a Special Use Permit to modify the existing tower located at 212 Washington Street. As recommended by CMS, the Special Use Permit is subject to compliance with the following conditions prior to the issuance of said permit and/or a Certificate of Completion:

- 1. To prevent warehousing of permits or authorizations and to assure the best service to the City's residents as expeditiously as possible, the facility must be built activated and be providing service no later than one hundred eighty (180) days after the issuance of the Special Use Permit or other applicable authorization, subject to commonly accepted *force majeure exceptions* acceptable to the City. T-Mobile may petition the City for an extension of this for good cause, but the decision whether to grant the extension shall exclusively be the prerogative of the City.
- 2. Contractor information with construction schedule must be provided to both the City and CMS prior to the request for issuance of the building permit. Once T-Mobile has met all the conditions of the permit and any other requirements of the City and a building permit is issued, they must notify the City's consultant for all inspections.

- 3. At the completion of construction, T-Mobile must notify the City's consultant and provide proof that all inspections have been satisfactorily completed and the project is ready for a final on-site inspection. Upon passing the final inspection, a recommendation to issue a Certificate of Occupancy shall be made.
- 4. The Certificate of Completion shall not be issued until all fees and costs associated with this Permit, including inspections, have been paid.
- 5. The provision of the Certificate of Completion for this work shall be a pre-condition for any future modifications of any kind by this carrier, at this facility.


